§ 1614.2 General plicy.

- (a) Except as provided hereafter, a recipient of Legal Services Corporation funding shall devote an amount equal to at least twelve and ball percent (2-1/2%) of the recipient's LSC annualized basic field award to the involvement of private attor twelvest udents, law graduates, and other professionals the delivery of legal services eligible clients this requirement is hereinafter referred to as the "PAI requirement" unds received from the Corporation as-one time special grants shall not be considerectalloculating recipient's PAI requirement.
- (b) Funds received from LSC as Native American or migrant grants are not subject the requirement. However, recipients of Native American or migrant funding shall provide opportunity for involvement in the delivery of services that attorney are students, law graduates, and ther professional a manner that generally open to broad participation in those activities undertaken with those funds, or shall demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Corporation that such involvement is not feasible.
