Dear Mr. McDonnell:

I recently received your request for a waiver under Part 1607 of the Legal Services Corporation ("LSC") regulations. I understand you seek to permit the partner and associate of an appointee Piedmont Legal Services Board member to receive compensation through Piedmont's Private Bar Involvement ("PBI") program.

The LSC regulations permit Piedmont Legal Services to request a waiver for PBI compensation. Section 1607.5(b) states:

Pursuant to a waiver granted under Section 1607.6(b)(1), a recipient may adopt policies that would permit partners or associates of attorney members to participate in any compensated private attorney involvement activities supported by the recipient.

1607.6(b)(1). A waiver for PBI compensation may be granted under § 1607.6 if the waived requirement is "not mandated by applicable law," and if the recipient demonstrates it cannot comply with the requirement because of, "the nature of the population, legal community or area served." § 1607.6(b),(b)(1).
