The range of sexual violence experienced by U-visa recipients included rape (8.57%); sexual assault (12.27%); abusive sexual contact (3.15%); trafficking (0.67%), sexual exploitation (0.40%); forced prostitution (0.27%); and female genital mutilation (0%). The survey sought to obtain a similar level of detail regarding U-visa recipients experience with forms of domestic and family violence and other forms of abuse that may not be perpetrated by family members that was experienced by survey participants. Survey respondents were asked to specify how many U-Visa recipients are victims of the following:

- Intimate Partner Violence/Domestic Violence
- Child Abuse
- Elder Abuse
- Stalking
- Dating Violence
- Abuse of the Disabled

Of the cases reported in the survey 88.63% experience one or more of these types of
