

- victim can still be deemed helpful; 15
- If victim continuously cooperated with law enforcement and case is dismissed due to mishandling of evidence, or conducting an unlawful search, the victim is still deemed helpful. 16

- Attending a line-up to identify perpetrator
- Providing a statement to police, even if there is no arrest
- Providing pictures of injuries
- Providing restitution information
